

## Register of Business Interests September 2017 – Full Governing Body

Department of Education guidance on statutory policies and documents says that maintained schools are required to keep a register of business interests of governors and the Headteacher from September 2015 and governing bodies will be under a duty to publish on their website their register of interests. The guidance says the register should set out:

- Relevant business interests of governors
- Details of any other educational establishments they govern
- Relationships between governors and members of the school staff including spouses, partners and relatives.
