

## French: KS3 Challenge Homeworks

### **Year 7**

1. Research and make a power point presentation to help other students understand and be able to one of the following verbs.  
AVOIR/ETRE/FAIRE/ALLER/JOUER/VENDRE/FINIR/ You can make quizzes, use pictures or teach the rules. Your choice!
2. Create a menagerie of your choice, in any format you wish, showing that you know the names of animals. Write a brief description in French of what you have created.
3. Research and present (in English) information about a famous or influential French character, and explain why you have chosen that particular person.
4. Create a game to revise the vocabulary and grammatical structures linked to a particular topic. You could use topics such as 'where I live'; 'my family'; 'my school' or 'my free time'.

## Year 8

1. Research and make a presentation or a game for a particular grammatical structure which you could then teach to or use with the class. Topics may include: the future tense with aller; the past tense; the past tense using 'être'; how to use modal verbs; how to use the verbs 'faire' and 'jouer' accurately.
2. Use a French recipe to make a cake using quantities and take a photograph of the recipe and cake to bring in to school.
3. Research a French holiday resort. Using the verb 'pouvoir' (conjugated) write a description of the types of things you can do in that place.
4. Challenge yourself to learn 3 new verbs in full and note down how you learned them, where you have used them and which method of learning was the most effective.

## Year 9

1. Learn five ways to ask questions in French and invent 5 questions which you can challenge the class with as a starter for a lesson.
2. Make a perfect tense powerpoint quiz to challenge the class and check their understanding of the formation and use of the perfect tense in French.
3. Research a French restaurant and make a menu based on what sort of food you can eat there. Write a review in French about the restaurant's menu using 'je voudrais manger chez *'name of restaurant'* car.....
4. Challenge yourself to learn 6 new verbs in full, including in the past and future, and note down how you learned them, where you have used them and which method of learning was the most effective.
5. Research how to form the conditional tense in French and create a powerpoint presentation or a poster which explains how it is formed in order to teach it to the rest of the class.
